Acceptance of applications for doctoral studies-from July 3 to August 3
Entrance exams - from 4 to 20 August **Enrollment-until 28 August**

1. Admission of persons to the doctoral program is carried out :on the basis of an international certificate confirming their proficiency in a foreign language in accordance with the common European competencies (standards) of foreign language proficiency:

2. according to the results of the entrance exam for the profile of the group of educational programs of doctoral studies and who scored at least 50 points out of a possible 100 points.

In the case of the same indicators of competitive points, the priority right for admission to the doctoral program is given to the persons who have the highest score of the entrance exam in the profile of the group of the educational program. Then the points for the essay, points for the test for readiness for learning, scientific achievements corresponding to the profile of the educational program are taken into account: scientific publications, including in the rating scientific publications included in the 1st, 2nd quartile according to the Journal Citation Reports of the Web of science database of Clarivate Analytics for the last 3 calendar years; certificates of scientific research; certificates of awarding scientific scholarships, grants; certificates / diplomas for participation in scientific conferences and competitions.



ATTENTION!

entrance exam in a computer format for applicants to the "D119-Technology of pharmaceutical production". Applications are accepted from July 3 to August 3. Entrance exams – from 4 to 20 August. Enrollment – until August 28.

The entrance exam to the doctoral program in a computer format consists of:

writing an essay;

a test for readiness to study in a doctoral program;

answers to exam questions on the profile of the group of the educational program.

The entrance exam to the doctoral program takes 4 hours. The final score is a set of points obtained by summing up the results of the assessment of the essay, the test for readiness to study in the doctoral program, the answer to the exam questions on the profile.

Scale of the 100-point rating system for admission to the doctoral program

essay	max 20 points
a test for readiness to study in a doctoral program	max 30 points
exam on the profile of the group of the educational program	max 50 points
Total	max 100 points



Admission to the doctoral program in the field of education "Health" is carried out in two stages:

- 1) pre-selection;
- 2) entrance exams.

The results of the pre-selection are admission or non-admission to the entrance exams.

The applicant passes the entrance exam for the group of educational programs of the doctoral program only in the educational organization to which he enters. The entrance exam for the doctoral program: "D139-Public health", "D140-Medicine", "D141 - Pharmacy" and "D151 - Nursing Science" is conducted by Karaganda medical university independently, according to the profile of the group of the educational program.

Appeal

- ☐ The Appeal Commission of the University accepts and considers applications from persons entering the doctoral program for the content of examination materials and technical reasons.
- ☐ Applications for the content of the examination materials and for technical reasons are accepted until 13.00 hours of the next day after the announcement of the results of the entrance exams and are considered by the appeal commission within one day from the date of submission of the application.
- ☐ The Appeal Commission works with each person individually. If a person does not appear at the meeting of the appeal commission, his application for appeal is not considered. When considering the application by the appeal commission, the person who filed the appeal provides an identity document.
- ☐ The Appeal Commission makes a decision by a majority vote of the total number of members of the commission



Applicants must submit the following documents for admission to the doctoral program:

- application addressed to the head of the university;
- a copy of the identity document;
- document of education (original and copy);
- international certificate confirming foreign language proficiency in accordance with the common European competences (standards) of foreign language proficiency;
- medical certificate form 075-Y ;
- six photos measuring 3x4 centimeters;
- personal personnel record sheet or other document confirming employment, certified by the personnel service at the place of work;
- list of scientific and methodological works (if available);
- the results of the preliminary selection (in the field of education "Health").
- paper folder, white;
- two envelopes;
- two files (dense).

Persons with a Master's degree and at least nine (9) months of work experience or who have completed residency training are accepted for doctoral studies.

Together with copies of the documents, their originals are provided for verification, carried out in the presence of the applicant. After verification, the original documents are returned. If you provide an incomplete list of documents specified in this paragraph, the admission committee does not accept documents from applicants.



To participate in the competition for the state educational order at the expense of the local budget, the applicant submits the following documents

Applicants are submitted to the admissions committee until August 25:

- 1) application (in any form);
- 2) document of education (original and copy);
- 3) an international certificate confirming foreign language proficiency in accordance with the common European competences (standards) of foreign language proficiency;
- 4) a copy of the employment record (if available);
- 5) a copy of the identity document;
- 6) the results of the preliminary selection (for doctoral studies in the field of education "Health").
